A Brief Introduction

Without God, I have a feeble memory; my mental aptitude is average – probably below average. I put myself through college. At that time, it seemed to be the best way to get a good paying job. College was hard. Each class had so many new concepts to try to understand, digest, and master. So much, that many students like me studied to just pass the tests - the joy of learning got crushed - departing after the first week of class. The tidal wave of concepts, facts, and information was too much to grasp and retain.

Average students like me found themselves “cramming” for midterm and final exams – reloading tons of information into short-term memory just before tests; it was too much information to hold and retain in long-term memory.

I did use a strategy, however, to help me better hold-onto things. I mean, why pay for expensive tuition and leave the institution with minimal long-term retention?

After every class, I would go home and re-write my notes so they were clear, legible, & organized. Many times, it is all a student could do - to *just write down* the information during a lecture – sometimes furiously taking notes - let alone understand it, digest it, and load it into memory. This is what I did at home, so I could feel confident I mastered that day’s lecture.

On day 2, I did the same procedure, *BUT* – I included a quick review of Day 1’s lecture. This was relatively easy to do. And so on. So, on Day 14, for example, reviewing all the lecture notes from 1-13 could be done rather quickly. And then I could retain it much better because it was being loaded into long-term memory. If this is not done, students will commonly find themselves on exam week trying to decipher all their earlier fuzzy semester

notes and wonder what most of them even meant! ... those notes being full of gaps and questions.

In some classes, I brought a mini tape recorder, and relistened to the lecture in addition to rewriting the notes.

When I first became a born-again Christian, I remember coming to God for some more **LIFE**. He communicated me something that basically went like this:

“Matt, you are like a water bucket with a bunch of holes in the bottom. I fill up your bucket but most of it just runs out. You forget what I have taught you and you lose it.

Now, you want to learn something more?

You need to hold-on to the things you were previously taught.”

**“MY SON, DO NOT FORGET MY TEACHING,
LET YOUR HEART KEEP MY COMMANDMENTS...
WRITE THEM ON THE TABLET OF YOUR HEART...”**

(Proverbs 3)

I was reminded of the way I studied, learned, mastered, and retained things in college – for long term memory.

Thus, reviews of multiple days’ previous spiritual learning and instruction were to become my daily habit and lifestyle.

Is not God and the Kingdom worthy of our utmost diligence? Yes!

It seems like Spiritual concepts, revelations, promises, truths, God's opinions, God's mind on matters, etc. - are a different type of understanding than academic educational knowledge – requiring a whole different level of diligence to attain & retain.

Some people that are naturally “smart” with high IQ's, can more easily, if not even casually, *learn and retain academic educational knowledge*. High aptitude and the ability for quick academic learning does not necessarily carry over to the Kingdom of God, however.

All people have to apply their whole hearts, souls, minds, and strength – to acquire and retain - the Gold of God... the Knowledge of God... the Mind of God... the Friendship with God, etc. And it requires work.

We have huge, powerful, dark demonic forces that attack us daily – vigorously seeking to have us question, forget, or even renounce the Kingdom truths we learn and are given.

We can easily be a professing Christian for many years and still be a baby Christian in reality – one of His sons or daughters that is not learning and growing and maturing into true Sonship.

The Apostle Paul admonished churches that were full of men and women who had been Christians for a while – but were still baby infant Christians. They still needed spiritual “milk” rather than chewable spiritual food.

They had not learned to retain even basic Christian truths, and still had to have them retaught. How sad and tragic to be one of God's sons or daughters – and acting like an ignorant carnal unbeliever. Let us never find ourselves at this place. It is a shame to Him and the Kingdom.

This “Daily Sticky Note Reminders” is a booklet I have been using (or ones like it every day) – for years...decades.

I need to daily re-grapple with...understand more fully...review every day...master...*and then do* the things contained it / them. I know you are like me. This is why we all need to do our best in our Training for God...

Concepts like:

- *The Lord’s Prayer and all its topics*
- *My Best Day for God TODAY*
- *What I Have Been Learning*

- *+ tons more. . .*

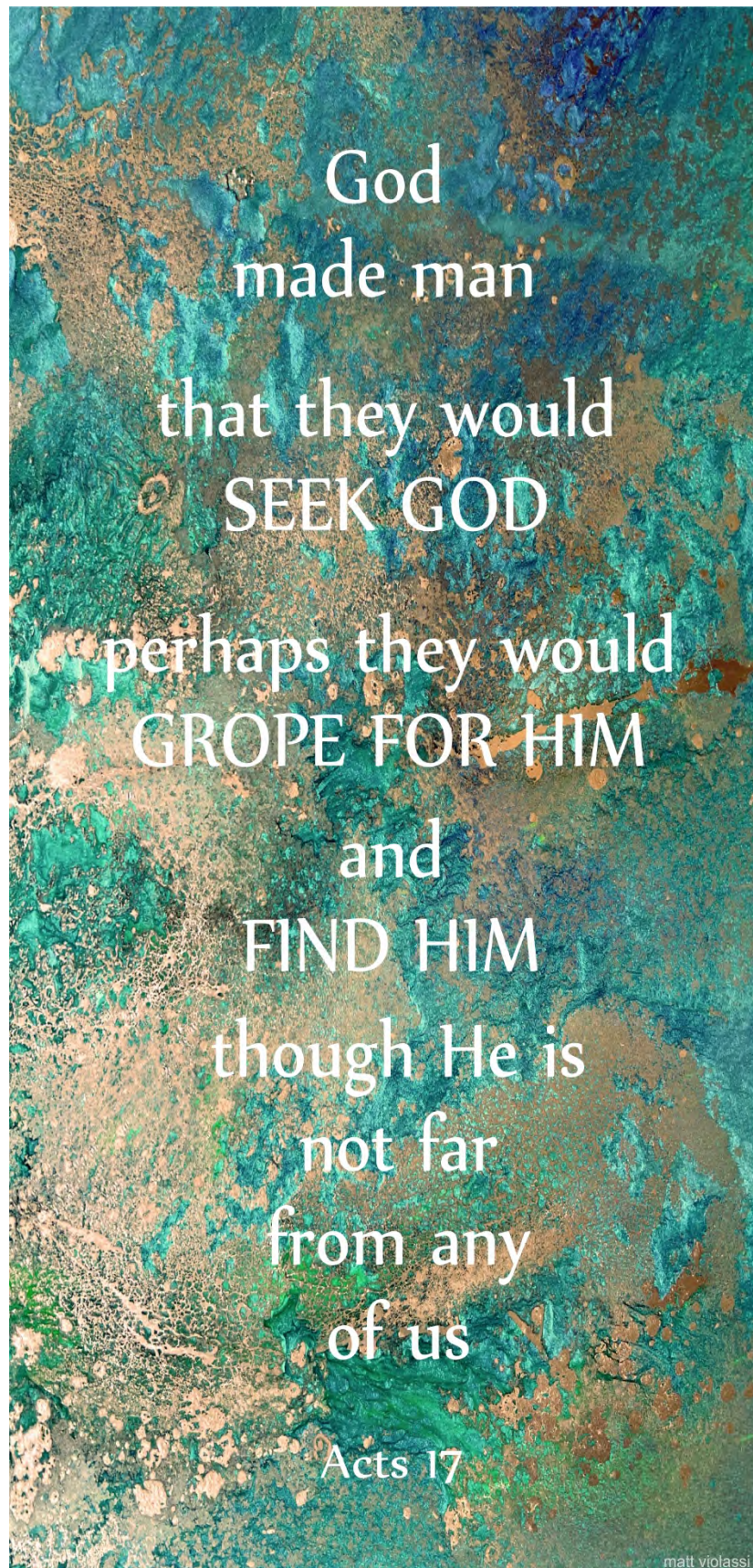
It is my desire that you use this booklet – or more importantly – **construct your own daily reminder booklet – and use it.**



Choosing the Twelve

¹²It was at this time that He went off to the mountain to pray, and He spent the whole night in prayer to God. ¹³And when day came, He called His disciples to Him and chose twelve of them, whom He also named as apostles: ¹⁴Simon, whom He also named Peter, and Andrew his brother; and James and John; and Philip and Bartholomew; ¹⁵and Matthew and Thomas; James the son of Alphaeus, and Simon who was called the Zealot; ¹⁶Judas the son of James, and Judas Iscariot, who became a traitor.

¹⁷Jesus came down with them and stood on a level place; and there was a large crowd of His disciples, and a great throng of people from all Judea and Jerusalem and the coastal region of Tyre and Sidon, ¹⁸who had come to hear Him and to be healed of their diseases; and those who were troubled with unclean spirits were being cured. ¹⁹And all the people were trying to touch Him, for power was coming from Him and healing them all.

²⁰And turning His gaze toward His disciples, He began to say, "Blessed are you who are poor, for yours is the Kingdom of God. ²¹Blessed are you who hunger now, for you shall be satisfied. Blessed are you who weep now, for you shall laugh. ²²Blessed are you when men hate you, and ostracize you, and insult you, and scorn your name as evil, for the sake of the Son of Man. ²³Be glad in that day and leap for joy, for behold, your reward is great in heaven. For in the same way their fathers used to treat the prophets. ²⁴But woe to you who are rich, for you are receiving your comfort in full. ²⁵Woe to you who are well-fed now, for you shall be hungry. Woe to you who laugh now, for you shall mourn and weep. ²⁶Woe to you when all men speak well of you, for their fathers used to treat the false prophets in the same way.

²⁷But I say to you who hear, love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, ²⁸bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you. ²⁹Whoever hits you on the cheek, offer him the other also; and whoever takes away your coat, do not withhold your shirt from him either. ³⁰Give to everyone who asks of you, and whoever takes away what is yours, do not demand it back. ³¹Treat others

the same way you want them to treat you. ³²If you love those who love you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners love those who love them. ³³If you do good to those who do good to you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners do the same. ³⁴If you lend to those from whom you expect to receive, what credit is that to you? ³⁷Do not judge, and you will not be judged; and do not condemn, and you will not be condemned; pardon, and you will be pardoned. ³⁸Give, and it will be given to you. They will pour into your lap a good measure—pressed down, shaken together, and running over. For by your standard of measure it will be measured to you in return."

³⁹And He also spoke a parable to them: "A blind man cannot guide a blind man, can he? Will they not both fall into a pit? ⁴⁰A pupil is not above his teacher; but everyone, after he has been fully trained, will be like his teacher.

⁴¹Why do you look at the speck that is in your brother's eye, but do not notice the log that is in your own eye? ⁴²Or how can you say to your brother, 'Brother, let me take out the speck that is in your eye,' when you yourself do not see the log that is in your own eye? Jesus ***Defined*** what ***"Loving Him His Way"*** looks like:

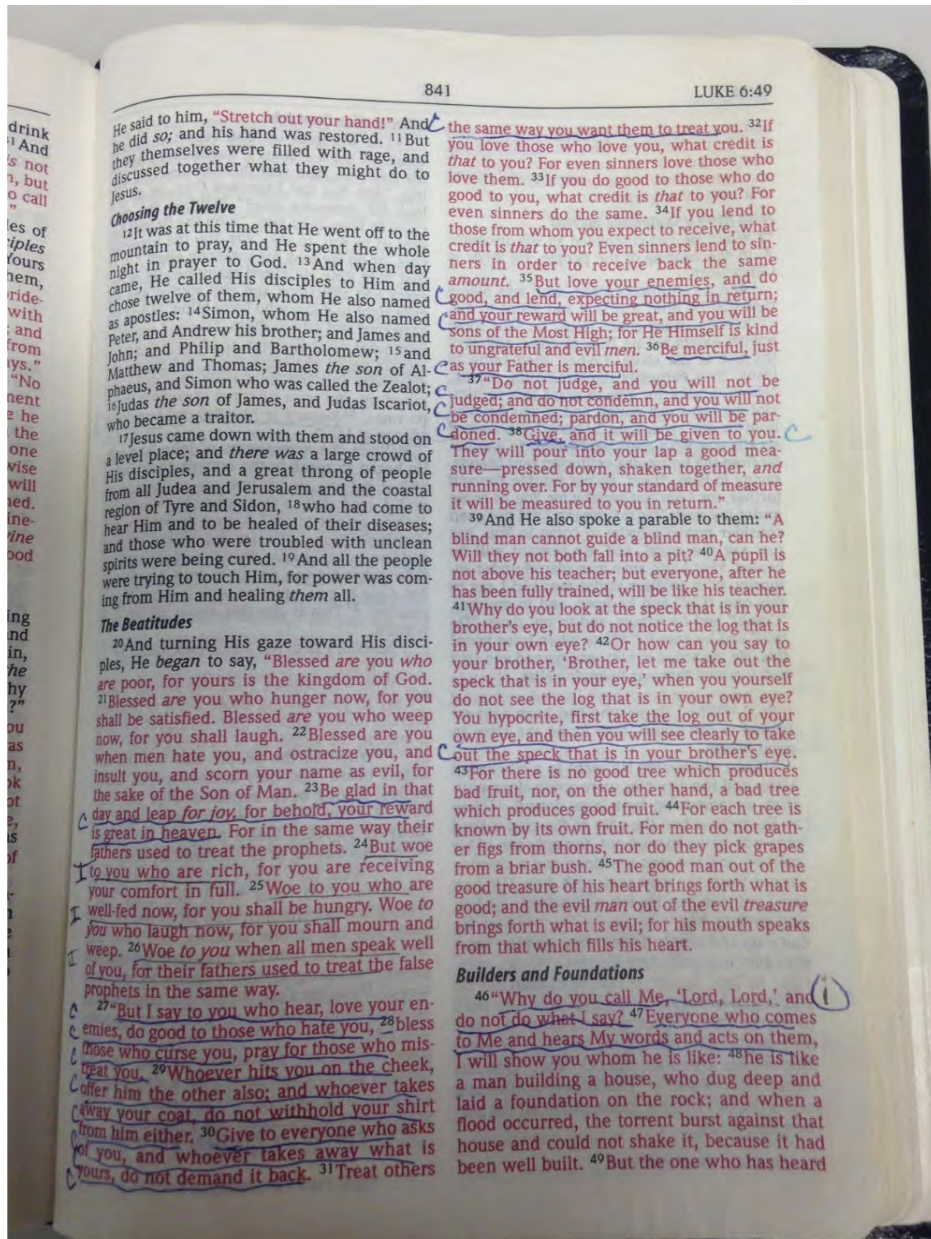

- Jesus's words are the easiest to find in a **red-letter bible**, where all His words are printed in **Red**:



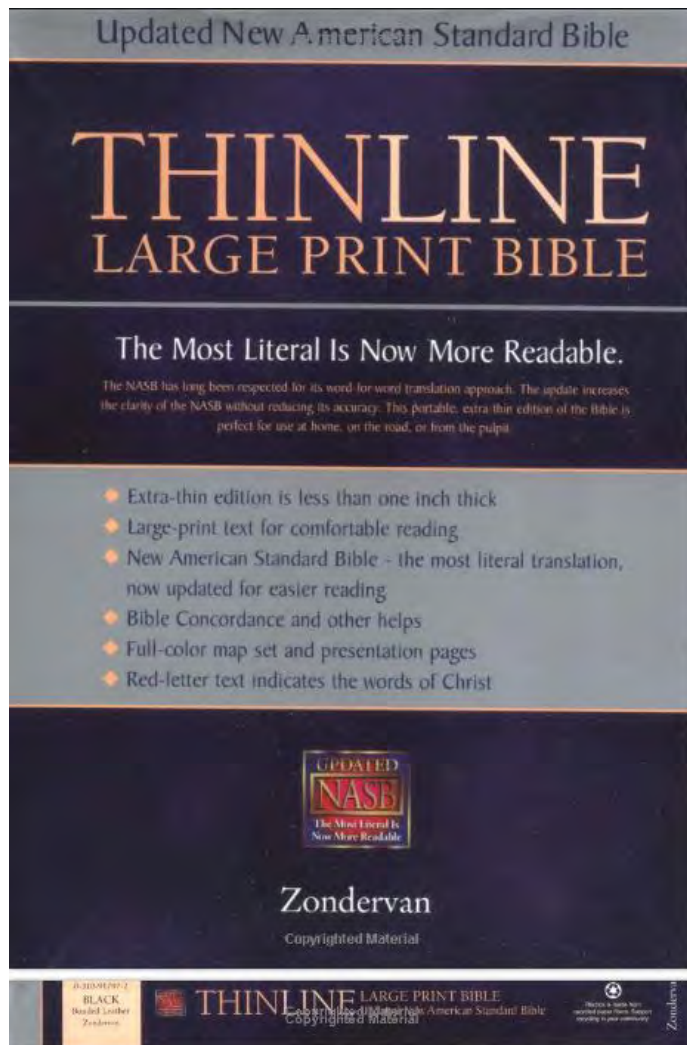

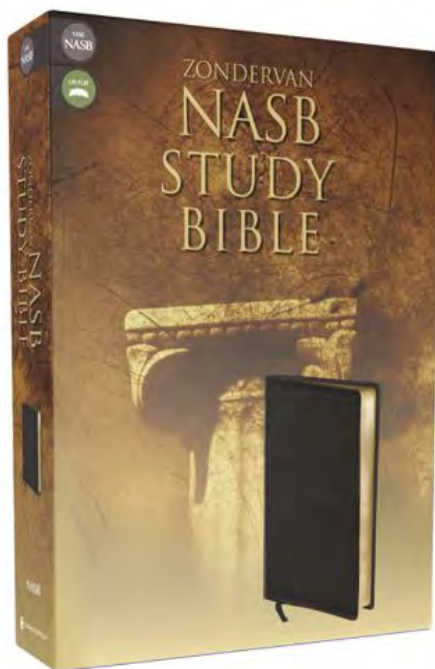
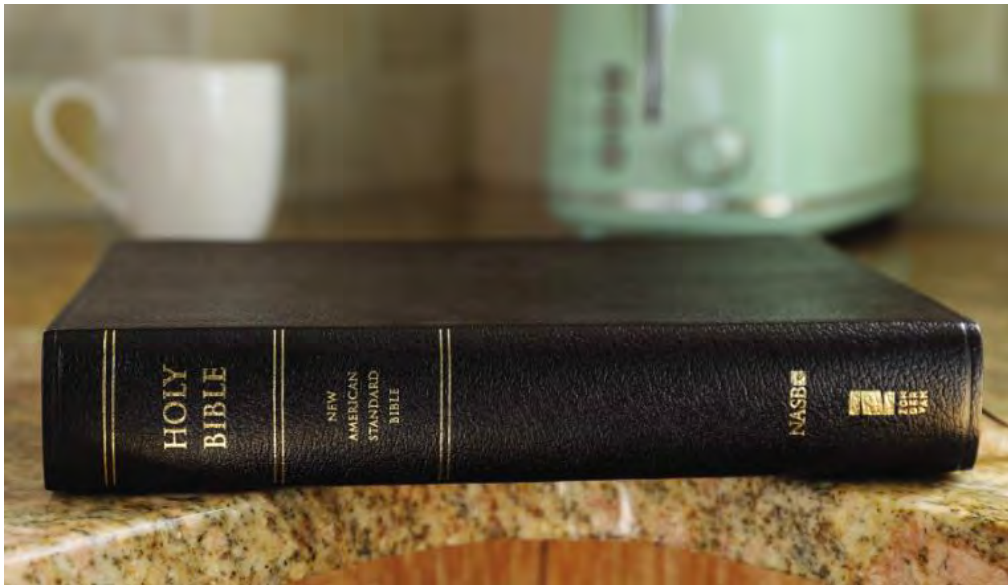

19 "You know the commandments, ^aDo NOT MURDER, DO NOT COMMIT ADULTERY, DO NOT STEAL, DO NOT BEAR FALSE WITNESS, DO NOT defraud, HONOR YOUR FATHER AND MOTHER."

20 And he said to Him, "Teacher, I have kept ^aall these things from my youth up."

21 Looking at him, Jesus felt a love for him and said to him, "One thing you lack: go and sell all you possess and give to the poor; and you will have ^atreasure in heaven; and come, follow Me."

22 But at these words ^bhe was saddened, and he went away grieving, for he was one who owned much property.

23 And Jesus, looking around, ^asaid to His disciples, "^aHow hard it will be for those who are wealthy to enter the kingdom of God!"

24 The disciples ^awere amazed at His words. But Jesus ^aanswered again and ^asaid to them, "Children, how hard it is to enter the kingdom of God!"

25 "^aIt is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God."

26 They were even more astonished and said to Him, "Then who can be saved?"

27 Looking at them, Jesus ^asaid, "^aWith people it is impossible, but not with God; for all things are possible with God."

10:11 *Whoever divorces his wife.* In Jewish practice divorce was effected by the husband himself, not by a judicial authority or court. *commits adultery against her.* A simple declaration of divorce on the part of a husband could not release him from the divine law of marriage and its moral obligations—this enduring force of the marriage bond was unrecognized in rabbinic courts. But see note on Matt 19:3; see also Matt 19:9, where an exception is mentioned. 1 Cor 7:15 may contain another exception (see notes on 1 Cor 7:12, 15).

10:12 *she is committing adultery.* In this historical and geographical context, Jesus' pronouncements confirm the bold denunciation by John the Baptist and equally condemn Herod Antipas and Herodias.

10:14 *kingdom of God.* See note on Matt 3:2. *belongs to such as these.* The kingdom of God belongs to those who, like children, are prepared to receive the kingdom as a gift of God (see note on v. 15).

10:15 *Truly I say to you.* See note on 3:28. *like a child.* The point of comparison is the usual openness and receptivity of children. The kingdom of God must be received as a gift; it cannot be achieved by human effort. It may be entered only by those who know they are helpless, without claim or merit.

10:16 *and began blessing them.* Jesus visually demonstrated that the blessings of the kingdom are freely given.

10:17 *a man.* Mark does not identify the man, but Luke (18:18) calls him a "ruler," meaning he was probably a member of an official council or court, and Matthew (19:20) says he was "young." *what shall I do . . . ?* The rich man was thinking in terms of earning righteousness to merit eternal life, but Jesus taught that it was a gift to be received (see v. 15). *eternal life.* See note on Matt 19:16.

10:18 *Why do you call Me good?* Jesus was not denying His own goodness but was forcing the man to recognize that his only hope was in total reliance on God, who alone can give eternal life. He may also have been encouraging the young man to consider the full identity and nature of the One he was addressing.

10:19 *Do not defraud.* The prohibition of fraud may have represented the tenth commandment (against covetousness). If so, Jesus here mentions all six commandments that prohibit wrong actions and attitudes against one's fellowman (see Ex 20:12-16; Deut 5:16-21).

10:20 *I have kept all these things.* The man spoke sincerely, because for him keeping the law was a matter of external conformity. That the law also required inner obedience, which no one can fully satisfy, apparently escaped him completely. Paul speaks of having had a similar outlook before his conversion (Phil 3:6). *from my youth up.* Probably a reference to the age of 13, when a Jewish boy assumed personal responsibility for obeying the commandments.

10:21 *Jesus felt a love for him.* Jesus recognized the man's earnestness. His response was not intended to shame him by exposing failure to understand the spiritual depth of the commandments but was an expression of genuine love. *One thing you lack: go and sell all.* The young man's primary problem was his wealth (see v. 22), and therefore Jesus' prescription was to rid him of it. There is no indication that Jesus' command to him was meant for all Christians. It applies only to those who have the same spiritual problem. *treasure in heaven.* The gift of eternal life, or salvation. This treasure is not to be earned by self-denial or giving of one's material goods but is to be received by following Jesus. In giving away his wealth, the young man would have removed the obstacle that kept him from trusting in Jesus.

10:22 *he went away grieving, for he . . . owned much property.* The tragic decision to turn away reflected a greater love for his possessions than for eternal life (cf. 4:19).

10:25 *eye of a needle.* The camel was the largest animal found in the Holy Land. The vivid contrast between the largest animal and the smallest opening represents what, humanly speaking, is impossible.


10:27 *With people it is impossible, but not with God.* Salvation is totally the work of God. Every attempt to enter the kingdom

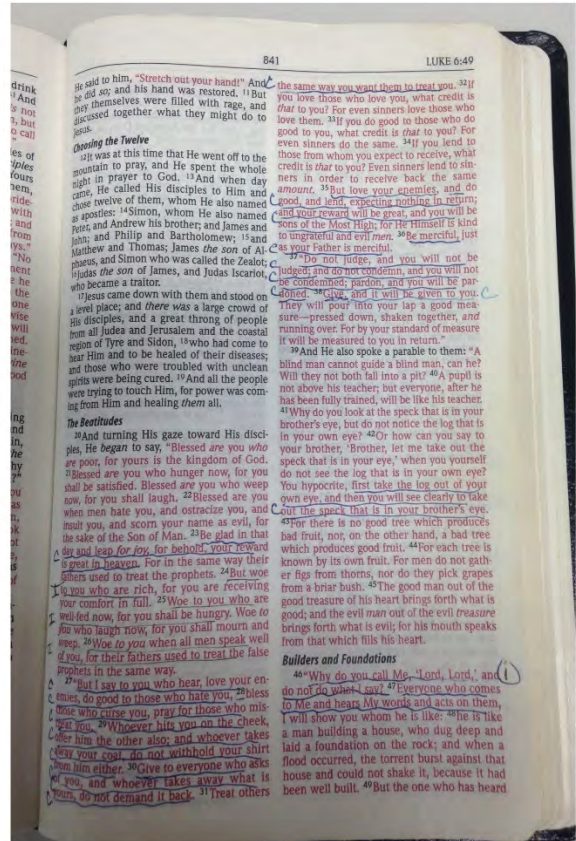



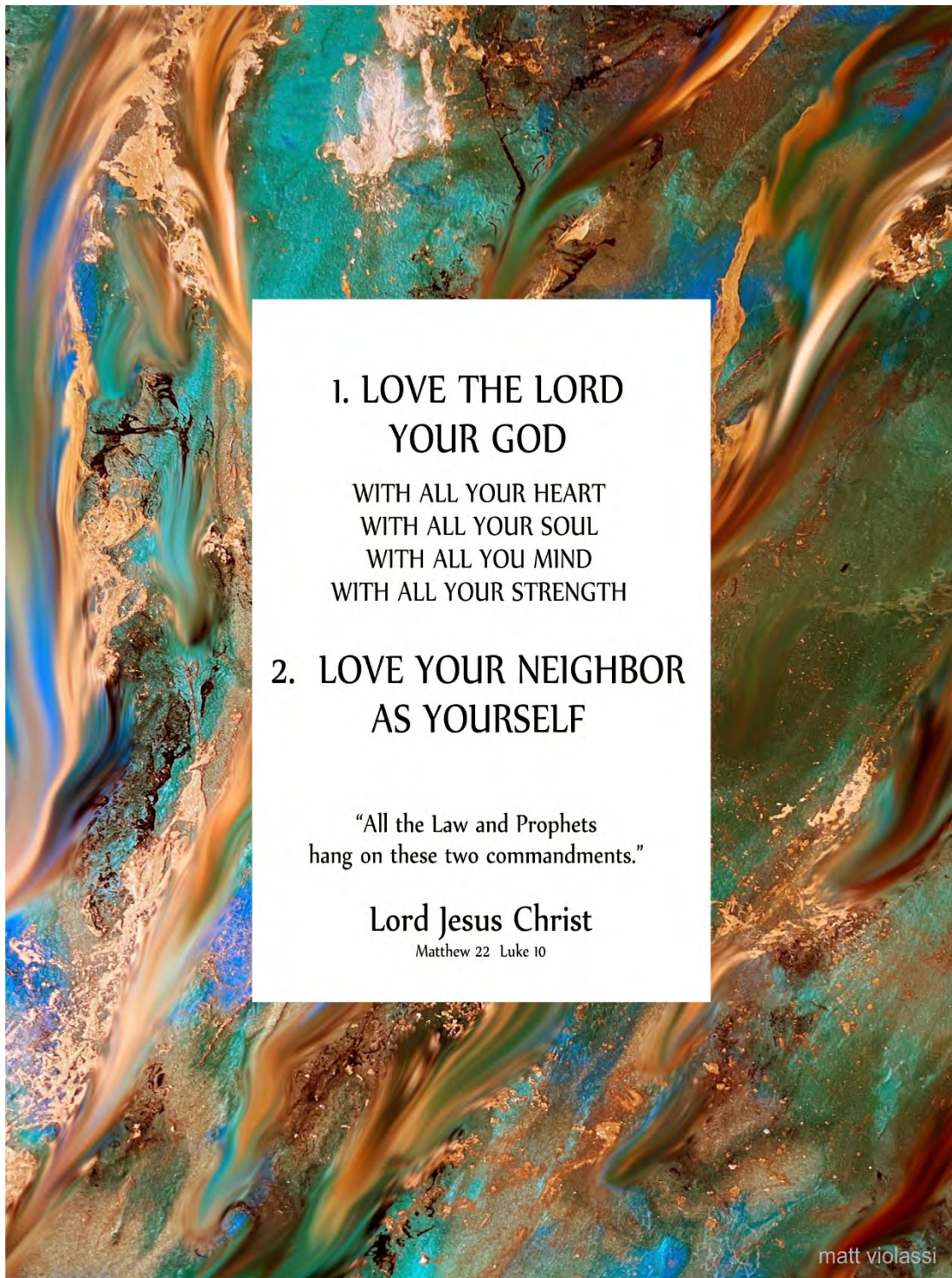

If we are stranded on a remote jungle island or a deserted land full of hostiles and without a Bible, we can fare okay just remembering these 2 commandments - all commands fall under these 2.

No one likes others to **LIE** to them, **CHEAT** them, **STEAL** from them, **SLANDER** them... **TREAT THEM MEANLY, UNNECESSARILY DISRESPECT** them, etc. Easy sins to judge for ourselves... Peace & Prosperity easy to come about on that island with everyone adhering to The 2 Greatest Commands only.

Command #2 **“Love Your Neighbor as Yourself” – “Treat Others the Way you Want to Be Treated”** – The standard for all is pretty easy *to judge* and then *do* based on these 2 Greatest Commandments. Peaceful villages and cities would result. *God would be more happy, most importantly.*

This sets-off a whole new journey with the question, "**How has Jesus loved me?**"

We probably all want the warm and fuzzy love of God and from others - all the time . . . (Me, too).

We all need to find and explore how Jesus has truly loved us - and then go love others in the same way.

This is because the way Jesus/God the Father loves us is a little different than the 2nd Commandment, "Treat others *the way you want to be treated.*" We want God to be nice to us all the time - the warm, fuzzy love from God - all the time. (Just like we want others to be all nice and happy and content with us all the time.) We want God loving us all the time without confrontations or disciplines, on account of our wrong-doings or perverted character/hearts.

He does not love us in this nice Santa Claus manner. *He is resolute on changing us into His image. He confronts us and He disciplines us as needed, like a good loving Father would and should.*

Thank God He does this gently – and then disciplining us with every-increasing pressure and pain until we “see” our stuff, acknowledge our stuff, and then repent and change from our stuff.

WOULDN'T WE TRULY WANT SOMEONE TO CONFRONT US ABOUT A WRONG LIFE-PATH WE ARE CHOOSING/ON - HELL FOREVER? SOMEONE TO PRESS US TO CHOOSE TO LOVE & SERVE GOD? OF COURSE ! This is an example of loving others in the way He has loved us – The Greatest Command #3.

Jesus said this is one of the major traits that marks and makes true Christians different from unbelievers. **Unbelievers cannot and will not do this in a pure way.** (It seems there is a lot of false, misguided, warped, and carnal and fleshly compassion for people(s) going-on nowadays – that is not based from God's love or coming from His perspective.)

We Christians seem to *barely* be able to truly love our enemies in the way God loves them all the time . . . the despicable, hurtful, repugnant, offensive, etc.

We can only do this with God's help and strength - to love the evil & despicable . . . those who deeply offend and injure us.

Let us continuously:

Remind ourselves of having God's pure love for our enemies,
Attain God's pure love for our enemies,
Maintain God's pure love for our enemies, and
Train ourselves in purely Loving our enemies.

It is a major difference-maker and testimony of true Christianity.

Just like Jesus did, we need to be telling the devil “What we are doing” (Luke 4:8) . . . “What we are all about” . . . What our life is "all about" . . . “We are all about Loving the Lord, and Serving Him only.” (Loving others correctly will come out of this.)



God wants us to grow-up in Him and be at a spiritual level where we can daily confess that we are doing these 7 things: Loving Him, Serving Him, Fearing Him, Following Him, Knowing & Keeping His Commandments, Listening to His Voice, and “Clinging” to Him.

Most professing Christians seem to not be able to make this confession.

Note: It is very interesting that the Old Testament believer was to be experiencing “Following the Lord.” This “following” was not merely doing #3 – “Keeping His Commandments.” It was receiving other specific direction for their lives – what they were to be involved in.

Also, they were to be “Clinging to Him.” How can any Old or New Testament Believer be “Clinging” to another person (especially God) without some kind of interaction / personal experience with that person? Men are commanded to also “cling” / “cleave” to their wives, too (Glue, Adhere, to Join, to Stick). Marriage is to be a picture of man’s relationship with God / God the Son. (The Apostle Paul said marriage was a mystery.)

This brings us to several questions. First, might be, "Why would I want to do this?"


